MILIEU will enhance the role of leader of IFS and let the institution attain a leading position at national level and the insertion in the international arena.

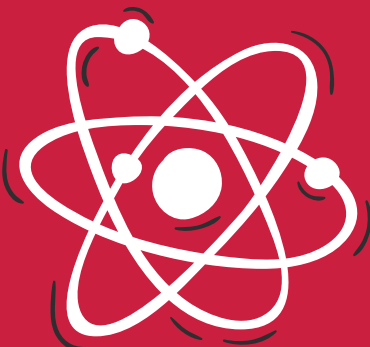


REPUTATION
